



Terms and Conditions, Biomolecular Imaging & Informatics 2026

1. GENERAL

The Society of Biomolecular Imaging and Informatics (“SBI²”) will hold Biomolecular Imaging & Informatics 2025, its 12th annual conference (the “Annual Conference”), from November 2 to 4 (inclusive), 2026 at The Renaissance Boston Waterfront Hotel, Boston, MA, USA.

The Applicant hereby makes application to obtain from SBI² a license to occupy and use exhibit space (“Exhibit Space”) that SBI² will assign during the Annual Conference, and/or to provide other financial support to SBI² or sponsor activities or awards (hereinafter, “Sponsorships”) at the Annual Conference as described in the Program Prospectus for Biomolecular Imaging & Informatics 2025. The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that by completing and executing the acceptance portion of this Application and upon its subsequent acceptance by SBI², this Application shall become an agreement (the “Agreement”) between SBI² and the Applicant governing exhibition (“Exhibition”) at the Annual Conference and/or financial support to SBI² or Sponsorship at the Annual Conference. The Applicant agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations governing Exhibition, financial support, and Sponsorship as set forth and included in the Program Prospectus and, as applicable, the Exhibitor Services Manual, a copy of which will be provided to each exhibiting Applicant (hereinafter, “Exhibitor”). Provisions in this Agreement applying to Exhibitors shall apply equally to Applicants whose Sponsorships entitle them to Exhibit Space without payment of an additional fee (hereinafter, “Sponsors”).

2. PAYMENT TERMS

Full payment is due on or before 5 p.m., Eastern Time, September 2, 2026 (the “Payment Deadline”). For any Agreement received after September 2, 2026, full payment will be due immediately upon receipt by the Applicant of an invoice from SBI².



If an Exhibitor or Sponsor does not make full payment for Exhibit Space rental or Sponsorship when due under the terms and conditions of this Agreement, SBI² may terminate this Agreement, and the Exhibitor or Sponsor will relinquish the reserved exhibition space or speaking slot and be responsible for payment to SBI² of all amounts that would have been due SBI² under the terms of the Agreement.

3. CANCELLATION

Any cancellation received after the Payment Deadline is subject to a 100% cancellation fee (“Cancellation Fee”). Cancellations received before the Payment Deadline are subject to a 50% Cancellation Fee. In the latter case, a written notice of cancellation by the Applicant will be required to secure a refund.

- a) Should an Exhibitor cancel after the Payment Deadline, the Exhibitor agrees to pay costs (“Redecoration Costs”) incurred by SBI² to redecorate or reconfigure the cancelled Exhibit Space in such manner as SBI² deems appropriate. Should the sum of the Exhibit Space rental fee and any Redecoration Costs, as calculated by SBI², exceed payments made by the Exhibitor before cancellation, the Exhibitor shall promptly pay to SBI² the outstanding balance.
- b) Sums payable by a cancelling Exhibitor or Sponsor shall be retained or received by SBI² as liquidated damages and not as a penalty. SBI² shall not require payment of, and shall refund any payments for, the fee applicable to the canceled Exhibit Space or Sponsorship in excess of the Cancellation Fee payable hereunder. Any refunds due to the Exhibitor or Sponsor as a result of the cancellation of this Agreement will be made immediately after the Exhibition.
- c) If Exhibit Space is not occupied by the Exhibitor by the designated set-up time prior to the start of the Exhibition, Exhibitor shall be deemed to have canceled the Exhibit Space contracted for, and (i) will have waived any right to use such space during the Exhibition, (ii) SBI² shall have the right to use such Exhibit



Space as it deems appropriate, and (iii) the Exhibitor shall pay SBI² all amounts that would have been due under the terms of the Agreement.

4. DISPOSITION OF UNCLAIMED OR ABANDONED EXHIBIT SPACE

Paid Exhibit Space unclaimed or abandoned by 5:00 PM, Monday, November 2nd, 2025, will be repossessed by SBI² without liability to SBI² and reassigned at SBI²'s discretion.

5. USE OF EXHIBIT SPACE

All demonstrations or other promotional activities must be confined to the limits of the exhibit (“Exhibit”) within the Exhibit Space. Sufficient space must be provided within the Exhibit for the comfort and safety of persons watching demonstrations and other promotional activities. Each Exhibitor is responsible for keeping the aisles near its space free of congestion caused by demonstrations or other promotions. No firm or organization not assigned Exhibit Space will be permitted to solicit business within the Exhibit area. The SBI² reserves the right to restrict Exhibits that, because of noise, method of operation, materials, or for any other reason become objectionable, and also to restrict or remove any Exhibit that, in the opinion of SBI², may detract from the general character of the Exhibition as a whole or consists of products or services inconsistent with the purpose of the Exhibition. This reservation includes persons, sounds, things, conduct, printed matter, or anything of a character that SBI² determines is objectionable. In the event of such restriction or removal, SBI² shall not be liable for any refunds or other exhibiting-related expenses. No animals may be offered as a part of the Exhibit; however, a guide dog that is present with a person requiring the guide dog will be permitted in an Exhibit Space to the extent allowed by applicable federal laws.

6. EXHIBIT SAFETY

Exhibitor accepts sole responsibility for any personal or property damage that may result directly or indirectly from any activities of the Exhibitor, including but not limited to the collapse of its Exhibit or any portion thereof or the existence of any other unsafe condition at the Exhibit, including booth setup/breakdown Exhibitor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold



harmless SBI², the owner and manager of the Exhibition facility (the “Exhibit Hall”), and others in the Exhibit Hall from and against any claim, loss, liability, or damage as a result of Exhibitor's construction or maintenance of an unsafe Exhibit, and Exhibitor further represents and warrants that it had obtained adequate insurance to cover its potential liability hereunder.

7. LIABILITY

Neither SBI² nor its agents or representatives will be responsible for any injury, loss, or damage that may occur to or be caused by the Exhibitor or to or caused by the Exhibitor's employees, agents, independent contractors, invitees, or property from any cause whatsoever. Under no circumstances will SBI² be liable for lost profits or other incidental or consequential damages. Exhibitors shall obtain, at their own expense, adequate insurance against any such injury, loss, or damage. SBI² shall not be liable for failure to perform its obligations under this Agreement as a result of strikes, riots, acts of God, or any other cause beyond its control. Anyone visiting, viewing, or otherwise participating in the Exhibitor's Exhibit is deemed to be the invitee or licensee of the Exhibitor, rather than the invitee or licensee of the SBI². The SBI² shall not be liable for any injury whatsoever to property of the Exhibitor or to persons conducting or otherwise participating in the conduct of the Exhibit or to invitees or guests of the Exhibitor. Exhibitor agrees to abide by existing agreements and regulations covering the use of services or labor in the Exhibition and Exhibit Hall. The Exhibitor assumes full responsibility and liability for the actions of its agents, employees, independent contractors, and invitees whether acting within or without the scope of the authority of the Exhibitor, and agrees to save harmless SBI² and the Exhibit Hall from responsibility or liability resulting directly or indirectly, or jointly, from other causes that arise because of the actions or omissions of the Exhibitor, its agents, employees, invitees, or independent contractors, whether acting within or without the scope of authority. There is no other agreement or warranty between the Exhibitor and the SBI² except as set forth herein. The rights of the SBI² under this Agreement shall not be deemed waived except as specifically stated in writing and signed by an authorized officer of the SBI². Any action that SBI² or Exhibitor may bring against the other, based upon or in any way relating to this Exhibit Space Agreement or its



performance, shall be brought in a federal or state court located within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and SBI² and Exhibitor do hereby waive all questions of personal jurisdiction or venue to give effect to this provision.

8. SECURITY AND INSURANCE

The Exhibitor is solely and fully responsible for its own Exhibit materials and should ensure its Exhibit against loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. All property of an Exhibitor is understood to remain in its care, custody, and control in transit to or from or within the confines of the Exhibit Hall.

9. CARE OF BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT

Exhibitors or agents must not injure or deface the walls or floors of the Exhibition building, the Exhibit Spaces, or the equipment of the Exhibit Spaces or Exhibit Hall. When such damage occurs as a result of the actions of the Exhibitor, its agents, employees, invitees, or independent contractors, the Exhibitor is liable to the owner of the property so damaged. All materials used in the decoration of the Exhibit and Exhibit Space must be flameproof. Electrical wiring used for the Exhibit and Exhibit Space must conform with the National Electric Code safety rules and all other applicable rules, regulations, fire laws, electrical codes and other laws of the city in which the Exhibition is located, and of any other government authority maintaining jurisdiction over the said Exhibition facility, which affect the installation, conduct and disassembly of the Exhibit. Combustible materials or explosives are not permitted in the Exhibit Hall.

10. TAXES AND LICENSES

Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for obtaining any licenses, permits or approvals required under local or state law applicable to their activity at the Exhibit. Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for obtaining any tax identification numbers and paying all taxes, license fees, or other charges that shall become due to any governmental authority in connection with their activity at the Exhibit.



11. FORCE MAJEURE

Except as Exhibitor's or Sponsor's obligation may be reduced in accordance with the terms set forth above, the Exhibitor or Sponsor shall be responsible for payment of the total Exhibit Space rental or Sponsorship fee whether the Conference and Exposition is canceled, delayed, or relocated, in whole or in part, as a result of riot, strike, civil disorder, act of war, act of God, or any other cause of any kind whatsoever not within the SBI²'s control; or rescheduled or relocated at the behest of the SBI².

12. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or the breach thereof, shall be settled by arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association in accordance with its Commercial [or other] Arbitration Rules, and judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof.
